**History**

Founded in 1934, the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission oversees bridges between New Jersey and Pennsylvania along the Delaware River. When first established, the Commission operated 18 bridges and then up to 20 bridges in 2010. The Commission has built new bridges for the river while maintaining upkeep on the pre-existing bridges. It is still in existence in 2020.
